 	1. Deluxe New Zealand Pinot Gris; Gisborne, NZ £7.99 13.5% ABV 2023 vintage Tasting note: <i>No one-trick pony, New Zealand makes highly popular pinot gris as well as excellent sauvignon blanc. Ideal for those who like their whites just off dry, this fruity and lightly spicy wine holds notes of pear and spice and works wonders alongside spiced prawn dishes or Thai fishcakes.</i>
2. Mighty Murray Chardonnay Andrew Peace Vineyards, S.E Australia £4.25 11% ABV Tasting Note: <i>This Chardonnay is a refreshing white wine with subtle tropical fruit and delicate citrus flavours. Light enough to enjoy on its own, or with a variety of different food.</i> <i>Supermarket Label: Creamy Citrus, Peach and Honey</i>

Freemans Bay Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand 2024 vintage £6.99 12% ABV Tasting Note: <i>An intensely fruity white wine produced with grapes from New Zealand's largest wine-growing region. The nose delivers hits of gooseberry, lime zest and passion fruit; and it boasts a rich and characterful palate.</i> <i>A classic, crisp Sauvignon Blanc bursting with tropical fruit flavours.</i>

4. Unearthed Thracian Valley Pinot Noir Rosé

Yamantiev Winery, Bulgaria

2024 vintage

Tasting Note:

A delicate, pale, salmon-pink appearance with expressive, red berry, fruit aromas of strawberry and wild raspberry. On the palate, ripe white peach flavours are complemented by subtle black pepper spice and a hint of bramble. The finish is fresh, complex and delightfully moreish.



5. Jailbird – Australian Blend Red Wine

Limestone Coast, Australia

Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz

Pour a glass and celebrate life's little rebellions. Jailbird is an enticing Cabernet Sauvignon dominated red blend, full of jammy red fruit, vanilla and a hint of spice to the finish. 6. Jammy Red Shiraz

Kooliburra, S.E. Australia

Tasting Note:

A red wine with soft sweet berry flavours and deep red ruby hues. On the nose are notes of cherry and red fruits, with gentle spice and soft tannins. Its juicy palate delivers sweet berry aromas with a clean and persistent finish.



7. Jaw Drop Syrah

Washington State, Columbia Valley

2020 vintage

14.5% ABV

Tasting Note:

Deep, inky purple with vibrant ruby hues. On the nose, intense and complex aromas of smoked meat, black pepper and violets for a floral lift. Rich yet elegant, with savoury flavours of black olive and spice. Blackcurrant compote and dark cherries elevate the finish.
